Water and electricity are dependable. School has fresh water catchment/tank but if it doesn't rain for two straight weeks to a month, staff are mandated or encouraged to conserve water. It does rain a lot but not all the time. Furniture is basic and minimal. Some housekeeping supplies are provided. Volunteer provides their own single-bed sheets, pillow, and towels. Employees provide their own food, however food are expensive. Due to limited housing, singles will be asked to share a room. Boys and girls live separately.

Due to limited accommodations, singles will be asked to share rooms. Boys and girls apartments are separated. Boys do not spend times at the girl's apartment and the girl's likewise. No pets allowed. No air conditions, fan is provided.

Acceptable:

Acceptable Dress: Men teach in long pants (no jeans) but may wear shorts off campus or after school. Men must wear collared shirts to church meetings. Women must always wear loose fitting skirts and dresses past the knee when going off campus or "in public" on campus. Women may wear modest shorts, slacks or pants only on campus in the evening or when exercising. During school hours, teachers have their own uniforms to wear.

Unacceptable:

Unacceptable Dress: Women - Tight and/or short shorts are never acceptable, nor sleeveless or sheer blouses or dresses. A conservative hairstyle is preferred for men and women. Please refrain from bringing or wearing jewelry.

- Regularly attend weekend services and assist in church programs according to talents and abilities.
