Summary

THE EXPERIENCE

The **MaxLife Revival** Tour is a Summer or Year-Long mission immersion experience designed for adults (18+) who are ready to go deeper with God, grow in discipleship, and catalyze a church-planting, multiplying movement. This is not a typical mission trip - it's a fully immersive training and lifestyle experience where participants learn to live Christ-centered, Spirit-filled, mission-driven lives in community with other passionate Adventists.

Beginning in May each year and ending in April the following year, this team of 8 selected individuals live in intentional Christian community while engaging daily in revival-forming practices, community outreach, discipleship, evangelism, and revival!

This program is designed for individuals seeking a more profound and structured religious experience. If you desire revival and want to experience what Jesus' disciples did when He called them away from their professions to become "fishers of men," this program is for you. MaxLife is currently engaged in a massive church-planting vision in North/Central Kentucky, with several churches (including Capital City SDA).

THE AREA

North/Central Kentucky is in a moment of spiritual crisis - and opportunity. With nearly half a million people in the three northernmost counties and just one active Adventist church per that population, the gap is vast. North American Division church-planting experts suggest that there should be **1 SDA church for every 25,000 people**. This creates an opportunity for 18 more churches across 10 counties in North and Central Kentucky!

THE OUTCOMES

Through the MaxLife Revival Tour, we are believing God for the following:

- *Selected Recruits* will learn by word and example what it is to live a Christ-centered, Spirit-filled, mission-driven life.
- *Selected Recruits* will learn revival-forming tendencies by closely studying the lives of inspirational revivalists and historical movements.
- *Selected Recruits* will be challenged to clear the way for the baptism of the Holy Spirit and revival in their

own lives.

- *Selected Recruits* will serve as catalysts for the North-Central Kentucky effort to plant 18 churches across ten counties.
- *Selected Recruits* will learn how to make disciples, utilizing the MaxLife Discipleship Curriculum core standards.
- *Selected Recruits* will form habits that produce revival long after their time in this program has ended.
- *Selected Recruits* will leave the experience having accomplished a major goal of choice that contributes to their future spiritual dream (ex, writing a book or portions of a book, reading the entire Bible, saving a determined amount of money for school or the start of a business/ministry, etc.)
- *Selected Recruits* will share their goals for the year and receive coaching, mentoring, and accountability in a group setting.
- *Selected Recruits* will be challenged to make Jesus Lord in eight major areas of their lives (health, finances, family, relationships, emotions, intellect, vocation, and purpose)
- *Selected Recruits* will strengthen their endurance, spiritual discipline, and resolve.

THE LEADERSHIP

A very general and broad description of duties include:

- Leading and assisting Bible studies and discipleship groups
- Participating in community outreach and relationship-based evangelism
- Supporting and helping lead evangelistic and revival meetings
- Engaging in one-on-one mentoring and disciple-making initiatives
- Assisting in church planting efforts and small group development
- Participating in weekly discipleship and leadership training sessions
- Contributing to prayer gatherings, revival weekends, and spiritual retreats
- Collaborating with a team (including church members from the area) to plan and execute committee outreach strategies and responsibilities
- Supporting mission trips (domestic and/or international)
- Weekly canvassing and church fundraising trips

WORK ENVIRONMENT & SCHEDULE ?

- This is a full-time ministry position tied to the annual MaxLife Evangelism Cycle (being used to plant churches in North-Central Kentucky)
- The Revival Tour volunteers join in May, with active fieldwork and community engagement intensifying through the year
- Requires frequent travel and work in various community settings
- Includes evening and weekend responsibilities based on events, meetings, and ministry needs
- Physical activity may be required during events, canvassing, mission trips, and outreach
- This program requires long days with intense schedules. To avoid burnout and maintain a healthy balance, rest periods and off days are built into the schedule.
