Health Notes

- General working conditions of a field Bible worker: e.g. door-to-door canvassing, general office work, teaching, and preaching.
- Physical requirements: requires standing, walking, sitting at desk, reaching, climbing, and lifting (maximum

of 50 lbs.)

- Ability to speak clearly to communicate instructions and clarify understanding.
- An equivalent of 40 regular hours per week to fulfill volunteer duties.
- Will require variable hours and some weekend work.

Dress

Acceptable:

No jewelry or outward adornment. No shirts with inappropriate or questionable graphics. This position represents the local church, conference, university, and the SDA church as a whole.

Duties

- **Bible work** - This is the main task. The student will work with the pastoral and SALT staff to systematically work the district, generating new studies and giving Bible studies.
 - **Training and Discipleship** - This is the 2nd major task. Working with the team, student will follow the designed plan to train and mentor church members as lay Bible workers.
 - **Evangelism Cycle and Calendar** - Assist in the execution of church calendar events, including the prayer initiative.
 - **SALT Mentor** - Assist with the SALT program as a mentor and liaison between SALT and the church. Mentor students during the practicum on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons.
 - **Mission Trip** - Assist the SALT team during the Thanksgiving break Dominican Republic mission trip.
 - **Miscellaneous** - Other Bible worker and mentor tasks as assigned.
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Experience

- **Education:** SALT graduate from either Southern Adventist University or Union Adventist University.
 - **Experience:** No prior experience required beyond what was achieved during SALT. Prior SALT mentorship experience not required but preferred.
 - **Driving:** Must have reliable transportation.
 - **Skill:** Interpersonal relationship skills, organizational abilities, self-starter, experience in Bible study and door-to-door evangelism—ability to teach, inspire to action in ministry, and preach is a key part of the function.
