This is not a lead teaching position. The volunteer will work under the supervision of school administrators, teachers, and the ESL coordinator. The primary purpose of the role is to provide encouragement, tutoring, mentoring, cultural support, and practical assistance to students who are learning English or adjusting to a new culture.

The ideal volunteer will see this position as more than academic support. It is an opportunity to build relationships, create a sense of belonging, and demonstrate Christlike hospitality to young people who may be far from home.

The volunteer may assist with the following:

- Provide individual and small-group English-language tutoring
- Help students practice conversational English
- Support students with reading comprehension, vocabulary, grammar, and writing

- Assist students in understanding classroom instructions and assignments
- Help students develop study habits, organization, and time-management skills
- Support supervised study halls and academic-help periods
- Help international students become familiar with school routines, expectations, and campus life
- Assist with new international-student orientation
- Help students adjust to American culture and boarding-school life
- Encourage international students to participate in campus activities, worship, athletics, clubs, and service opportunities
- Organize cultural-exchange activities and opportunities for students to share their home cultures
- Help coordinate peer language partners or student mentors
- Assist with airport-arrival preparation and student welcome activities when needed
- Communicate student concerns to the appropriate school employee
- Support teachers and administrators with appropriate international-student programming
- Participate in campus worships, spiritual activities, and community events
- Perform other student-support duties assigned by the supervising administrator

Ministry Responsibilities

Because Rio Lindo is a Christian boarding school, the volunteer will also be expected to participate in the spiritual life of the campus.

This may include:

- Attending chapel, vespers, and selected campus worship programs
- Building positive mentoring relationships with students
- Encouraging students in their spiritual growth
- Participating in service projects and outreach activities
- Supporting a campus culture of kindness, respect, inclusion, and belonging
- Modeling Christian character, integrity, patience, and compassion

The volunteer should be comfortable working with students from different religious, cultural, and linguistic backgrounds.
