Primary Responsibilities

The volunteer may assist with the following:

- Clean classrooms, offices, hallways, restrooms, common areas, and other campus spaces
- Sweep, mop, vacuum, and maintain floors

- Empty trash and recycling containers
- Clean and disinfect high-touch surfaces
- Restock paper products, soap, cleaning supplies, and restroom materials
- Clean windows, mirrors, doors, fixtures, and furniture
- Assist with dormitory room cleaning and preparation
- Help prepare facilities before students arrive and after students leave
- Support deep-cleaning projects during school breaks and home leaves
- Assist with cleaning after campus programs, banquets, meetings, athletic events, and special activities
- Help move furniture, equipment, and supplies when needed
- Report maintenance concerns, water leaks, damage, mold, pests, or safety hazards to the appropriate supervisor
- Maintain custodial closets and organize cleaning supplies
- Follow proper procedures for handling cleaning products and equipment
- Assist with laundry, linens, or related campus-support duties when assigned
- Participate in seasonal campus cleanup and beautification projects
- Work alongside student employees when appropriate
- Perform other custodial or campus-support duties assigned by the supervisor
