3. **Academic Continuity:** Monday–Thursday, 3:00 p.m.–6:00 p.m. — Students will complete assigned coursework from their U.S. curriculum to remain aligned with academic requirements.
4. **Service and Outreach:** Sabbaths will be dedicated to community service activities in partnership with **Korean ADRA**, promoting Christian service and global citizenship.
5. **Historical Exploration:** Sundays will include educational excursions to historical and cultural sites across Korea.
